The Finer Detail

Requirements	<p>Only 1 entry per artist, who should be amateurs – ie. artists not earning a living from their work.</p> <p>Entries must be clearly labelled or marked on the back with Title, Artist, Medium.</p>
2D (Flat work)	<p>Work must not exceed 240mm x 240mm, including any framing.</p> <p>All exhibits must be ready to hang, fitted with D-rings and taut wire or cord, fixed approximately one third from the top of the frame or canvas.</p> <p>If they are not ready for hanging they will not be accepted.</p>
3D (Free standing)	<p>Work must not exceed 450h X 450w X 200d mm (in any direction).</p> <p>The size of the work must be confirmed with the organisers.</p> <p>Please contact: Jenny Timms to confirm that your arrangements are suitable – jenny@vitreusart.co.uk</p>
Suitability	<p>The exhibitions will be visited by members of the public of all ages so work must be suitable for family viewing.</p> <p>If the organisers feel the work is unsuitable for family viewing it will not be accepted.</p>
Copyright	<p>Responsibility for respecting the copyright of any other person lies solely with the artist and participants indemnify the Organisers against claims of infringement.</p> <p>Work by artists must be their own; this includes art derived from photographs.</p>
Handing in	<p>Artist are requested to unwrap their exhibits before presenting for check-in.</p> <p>Please retain your packaging as we will be unable to store it.</p>
Moving artwork	<p>The art work will be moved from point of drop-off to 3 different destinations.</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Stony Stratford Exhibition – Stony Library 2. Wolverton Exhibition – The Old Bath House 3. Wakefield Country Courtyard – Wharf Distillery / The Barn <p>The organisers will move the artwork between venues, and they will do their utmost to ensure the art work isn't damaged in anyway, but of course this can't be guaranteed.</p> <p>By signing the entry form you indemnify the organisers from any responsibility for damage.</p>
Collection	<p>Work must be collected – we will notify you of details</p> <p>Any works not collected by the specified time may be destroyed, as there is no place to store work.</p> <p>If however, you are unable to make the collection time/date due to ill health we will endeavour to be as flexible as possible, but it is the responsibility of the artist to contact the organisers to arrange a different date or time at jenny@vitreusart.co.uk</p>
Insurance	<p>Exhibitors are advised to insure their work for all risks. Although all reasonable care will be taken, no responsibility can be accepted by the Organisers or the venues of the exhibitions for the loss or damage to exhibits.</p>

Any exhibit not complying with the rules will not be displayed.
 No refund will be made and the organising committee's decision in any instance relating to the competition and exhibitions is final.
